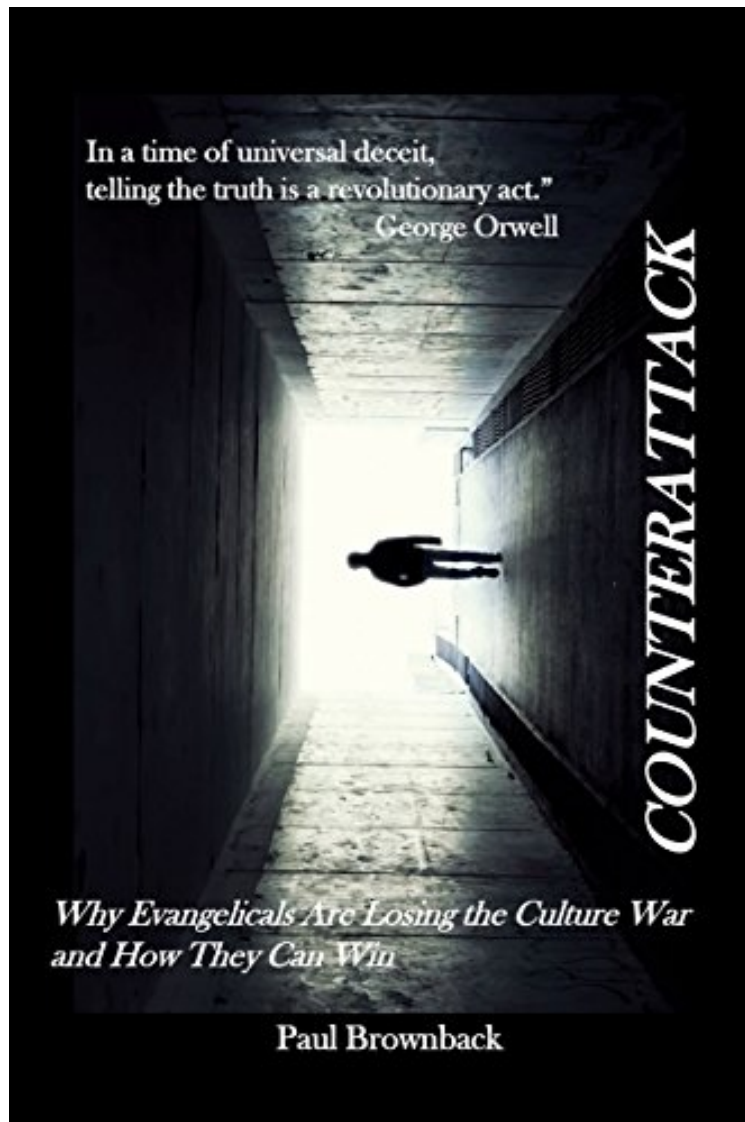

Paul Brownback traces a major shift in viewpoint that an influential minority has successfully infiltrated American Culture with. As a society, we Americans look with nostalgia back on the upheavals of the 60's without giving much thought to what they really represent. We have become utterly infiltrated as a culture by all-consuming Subjectivism. The cultural influence of genuine Christianity, meanwhile, to a very large extent, has

been equally infiltrated and lost its power. We, as the Evangelical Church, have been neutralized as a major force and influence for truth by a very subtle acceptance of false teaching. We have largely left the battle for influence on our culture. The major value of this book is its clear review of the process by which the church has lost its savor as salt in America, along with the dimming of its light, and how it can regain that God-designed role. The author authoritatively rebukes the American church, calls it to repentance, and presents an outline for organizing to fight. The nearly lost battle against those who have been actively fighting and winning the Culture War has almost been ignored by the church. For a whole generation the offensive has been from the Left while resistance has been scant. The whole tenor of this book is very positive and logical, but many Christians will have a hard time accepting its diagnosis of the terminal, yet treatable disease that has infected them. The nature of this penetrating false doctrine has an auto-immune quality to it--the body is confused, and it attacks itself in areas that are not the true problem that is degrading its health. Its natural immunity being neutralized, the body (the church in this case) can't detect and fight the real problem. This book sheds vital light for the exposure and remedy of the central problem that has debilitated the church and brought it out of action. The concept of unconditional acceptance (unconditional love) has penetrated the central nervous system of the church and reeked havoc on a multitude of its natural functions. Failure to recognize and fully address this problem soon will result in an utter loss for both church and the larger society of this once-great country. This author has a passion to alert us to the problem and see it turned around. We Christians would do very well to listen and act upon his practical message of hope and call to action.

Mainstream Americans are tired of being abused by the Left, which dominates both political parties, the courts, the media, and our educational institutions. They are incensed at being robbed of their money and their country. They are angered by watching the Left trash the economy, the military, the Constitution, and morality. Most of all, they are utterly frustrated that nothing they do makes a difference, that their vote does not precipitate change. In brief, they are tired of being defeated in the culture war. The solution resides in a counterattack with the objective of restoring our previous Christian culture. The evangelical church must lead that offensive. However, because it has become infiltrated by the core concept of our failing post-Christian culture the American evangelical church is too weak to engage effectively in the culture war. This book describes the core concept of secular culture that is ruining our nation, shows how that concept has infiltrated the American evangelical church, proposes a path back to spiritual health for the church, and provides an effective strategy through which the church can win the culture war against the Left.
