I was really just looking for a paperback book filled with many short stories, since I have a short attention span when reading. I was expecting a

small paperback, but this book is huge! It contains many short stories (1-3 pages), and it also contains a large section on Native American history which includes some old photos. I like how the stories are concrete, with no room for interpretation. For instance, some of the stories contain an unknown variable, and that's that. There is no speculation, that is just the way it was, and the story moves forward. Most of the stories include the plants and animals of the forest (which often were unhappy with man), and many of their characteristics are often explained in these stories. Clearly, the Native Americans had more respect for the natural world than we do.
