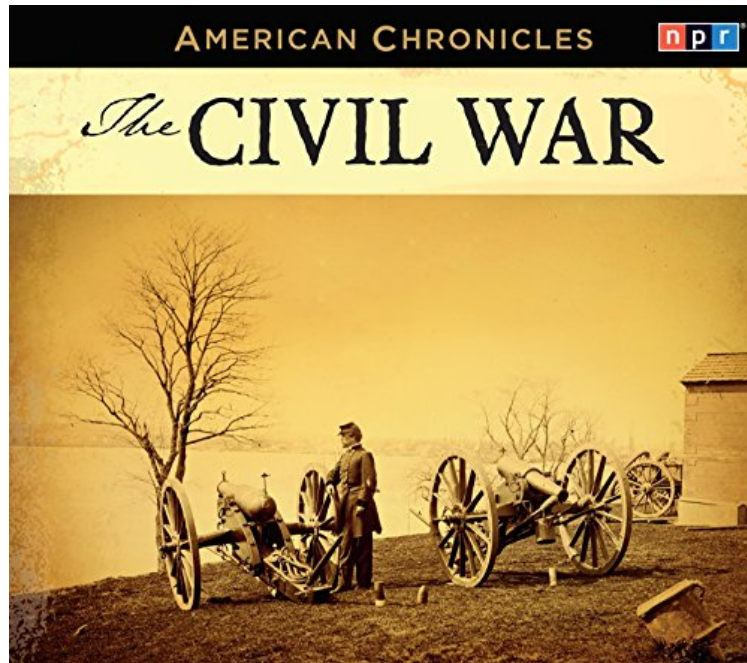

Sumter attack a few days back; or pop in the documentary (The Civil War - A Film by Ken Burns) that made us fall in love with the event and Ken Burns; or read a book or two (March or Confederates in the Attic: Dispatches from the Unfinished Civil War). Celebrate is such a strange word, isn't it? Do we want to celebrate the deaths of over a million people? More like commemorate. We reflect, we remember, and in turn, we make the sacrifice that started 150 years ago of the brave soldiers fighting to keep a country united and to free an enslaved people. NPR has tossed its aural hat into the ring by producing a wonderful collection of stories, "NPR American Chronicles: The Civil War". Hosted by Neal Conan, this three disc set is some of the best Civil War stories compiled by NPR. Once again, we hear the southern drawl of Shelby Foote as he explains the significance of the war on southerners; the plaintive tones of Sam Waterson give the Gettysburg Address (is there a better voice for that?); Susan Stamburg bringing Lincoln alive from his summer retreat. It's quite a cornucopia of listening, something for everyone; historians, book lovers, battlefield experts, the general public. One story that absolutely touched me was a woman recounting a story of taking her grandchildren to see the Emancipation Proclamation; how this "dry document" freed four million people. Wonderful. As someone

who spend a ton of time driving around in his car, this collection is going to be with me. It unfortunately ends much too soon.
