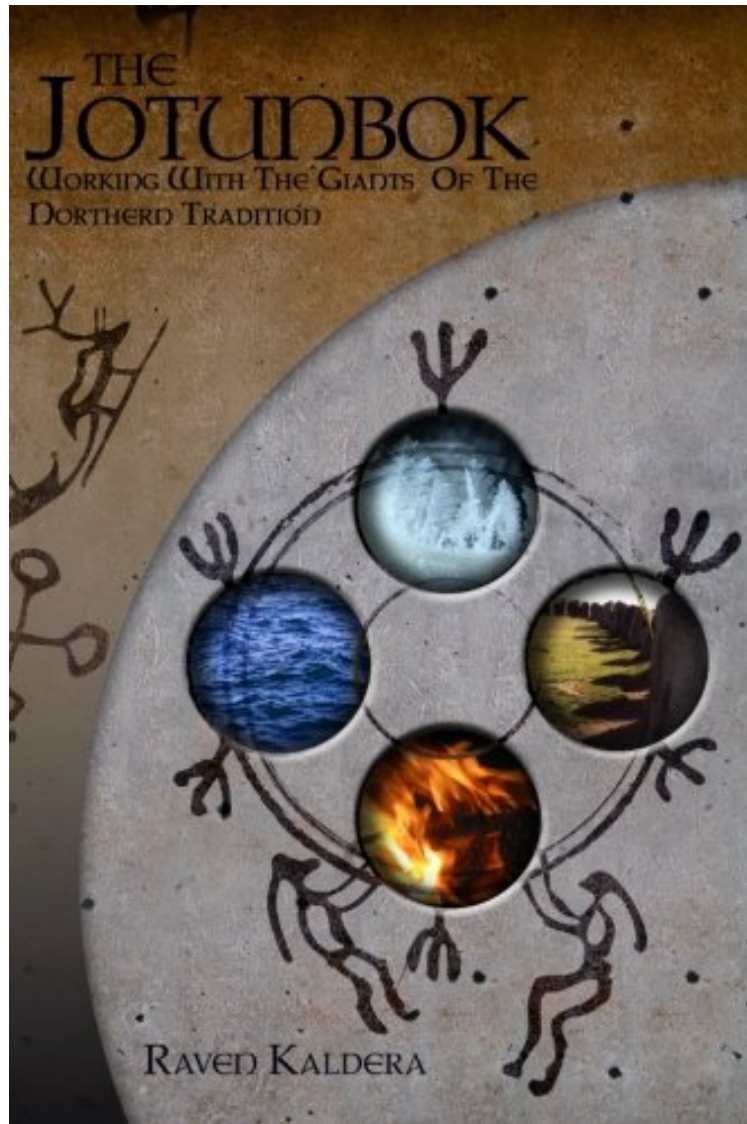

that I found it hard to find information to relate to Them on. I tend to research quite a bit before interacting with new spirits, Deities included, and when this book finally came to me, I was impressed by both the work, and the dedication of the author and contributors to forging and maintaining the relationships within the book. I never worked with the Nine Undines prior to picking up this book; now I have, and will on occasion work with Them as called to. I liked the emphasis on personal relationship-building with the Jotun in the book, in that the work was a good guide, but the person reading actually had to do the work for the benefits the guidance might bring. This is something that very few books actually state out-loud, and that I think through this requirement, the book requires positive growth from the reader.
