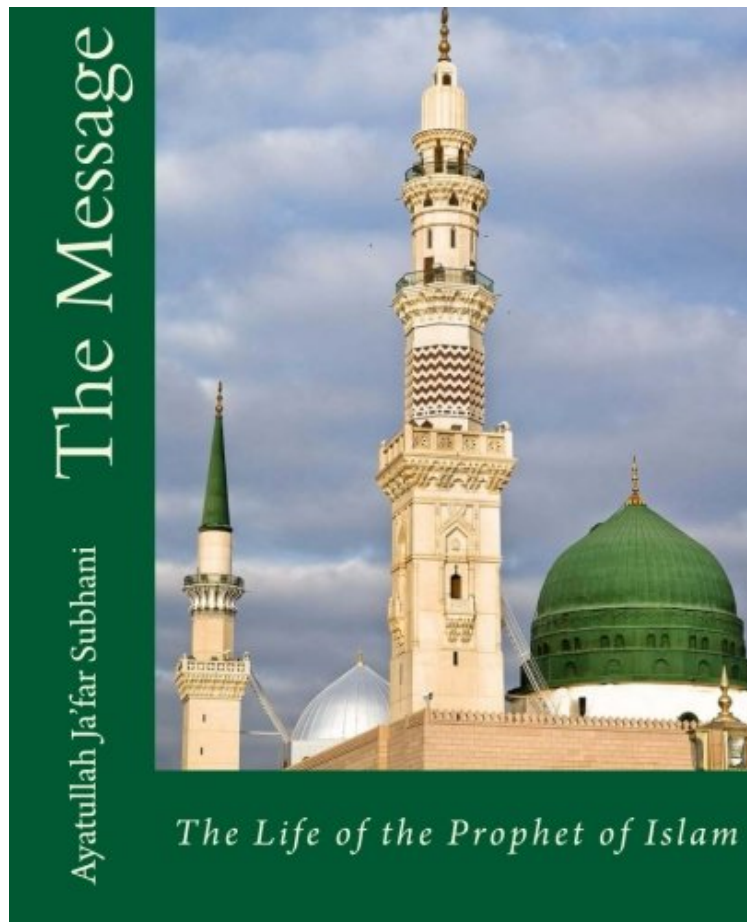

After the Quran, it was one of the earliest Muslim books ever written, either just before or just after Imam Malik's Muwatta, or compilation of legal traditions of the Prophet, appeared. The Message, using both Sunni and Shia sources, shows that Ibn Ishaq paints the Prophet in the image of the Imperialistic Caliph rather than a true Prophet of God. The last ten years of his life in Madina, his intensifying the efforts of his mission for the spread of Islam, his participating in the numerous battles with the infidels and the final conquest of Makkah are still greater events which are seemingly unbelievable, but have been recorded in history as miraculous achievements.
